

Bio – September 2026 NISG Group Meeting Presenter – Corey Roulston, Group Environmental Sustainability Coordinator at Foyle Food Group



Corey Roulston is the Group Environmental Sustainability Manager at Foyle Food Group, with responsibility for co-ordinating 5 sites over 8 business units across Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland and GB. He has been working in Environmental roles for the past 6 years, starting in Wastewater Chemistry and progressing to Environmental Management and Sustainability. Corey has an educational background in Biotechnology, holding an MSc in Molecular Biology & Biotechnology and a BSc in Pharmaceutical Biotechnology from Queen's University Belfast.

His first introduction to climate science and sustainability was during research for his MSc thesis, with the Huws Group at QUB. This research group aims to reduce methane emissions from ruminants, and Corey's specific project was in mapping the rumen microbiome resulting in one isolate being revealed to be a new species of potent, previously uncultured rumen bacteria. His thesis was subsequently published.

Corey's role at Foyle Food Group is focused on ensuring sustainability is at the heart of the business, with the commitment to deliver ambitious science-based emissions targets and inspire positive change across their supply chain and local communities.
